



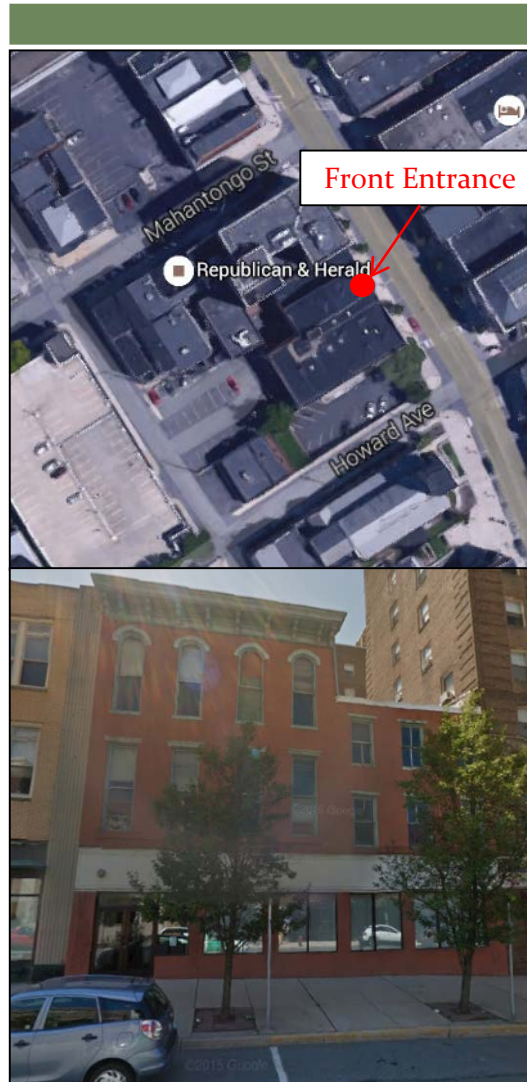

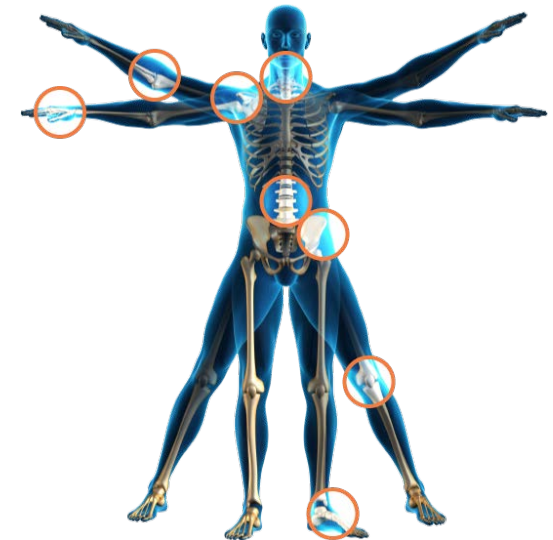

What to Expect

All new patients receive an initial evaluation from the Doctor. After the patients' needs are assessed, a treatment plan is then established by the Doctor. Depending on the nature of the diagnosis, a treatment plan could consist of several options. These include, but are not limited to, injections for pain control and/or measurement for a custom fit brace.

The doctor may also recommend in office therapy sessions. Therapy is conducted by the office's Clinical Kinesiologist. In order to begin therapy, an initial evaluation is performed by the Doctor and Kinesiologist to identify the specific needs of each patient.

From the initial assessment, an individualized therapy plan is established by the Doctor and Kinesiologist. Personalized at home therapy plans are made specific to each patient. Detailed handouts are sent home with each patient. Doctor is informed of progress daily.
